Text: Precalculus: Functions and Graphs

Course Description: We will cover chapters 1-3, 7-9 of the text. Chapter P is considered a prerequisite.

Homework: Homework is assigned every day, although it will not be collected or graded. But the weekly quizzes will be similar if not identical to the homework assigned.
